SUBJECT: Asbestos Management Plans

As an official representative of a parent, teacher, or employee group, you are asked to relay the following information to members of your organization:

The School District of Palm Beach County, in accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (AHERA), has developed and maintains an asbestos management plan for your facility. The plan contains a statement from the project architect indicating that asbestos containing building materials were not specified during construction of your facility. However, asbestos containing materials may be present in portable classrooms but not modular or concrete classrooms located on your campus.

At present, District policy requires that all building materials within portable classrooms that contain or are assumed to contain asbestos be inspected periodically to insure they remain in a safe condition. Damaged materials, or materials that are subject to damage due to a pending renovation or maintenance activity, will be sampled to determine asbestos content and dealt with accordingly.

A copy of the management plan can be found in the main office of your facility, or the School District's office of Environmental and Conservation Services. The plan is available for public inspection during normal business hours. Persons interested in reviewing the management plan are requested to contact the school principal, facility manager, or the School District's office of Environmental and Conservation Services at (561) 684-5154.
